<u>VersusIO</u> compares tech products by using official specifications from the manufacturer, stripping out subjective information like opinion and matters of taste.

<u>Universe Today</u> runs a YouTube channel hosting programmes and documentaries but they also hold regular Virtual Star Parties in Google Hangouts where contributors with telescopes train them on the skies.

The Aspie Show talks openly about Asperger's syndrome, celebrating the strengths it brings to the human mind rather that seeing it as a disability.

<u>Mind of Man</u> is an iOS app claiming to analyse the language, content and other stats gleaned from Twitter interactions to create a visualisation of your personality called a Mind Print.

<u>Social travel site Minube</u> has been popular through much of Europe and Latin America for some time and has just added English-language versions.

Google's 100,000 Stars experiment creates a 3D graphic of our galaxy, zooming through the solar system before skirting the edge of the Milky Way.
